**Attention All Slip Holders**  
**" ELECTRICAL SAFETY"**

It is extremely important to check your marine power supply cords and the pedestal receptacles that you plug into. Your plug should twist lock in, if there is any overheating discoloration or burnt items the cord should be unplugged immediately.

The boat owner is responsible to replace or have repaired any cord or cord end, MYC will replace the receptacle only, when reported in writing and deposited into the Dock Master's Drawer.

The above problems and other problems are causing stray currents in our club waters causing zinc replacements and possibly other issues . **Other safety items,** SHUT OFF the circuit breaker before unplugging or plugging in your Marine Cord, Check and repair or replace a damaged boat wiring AC or DC.
